

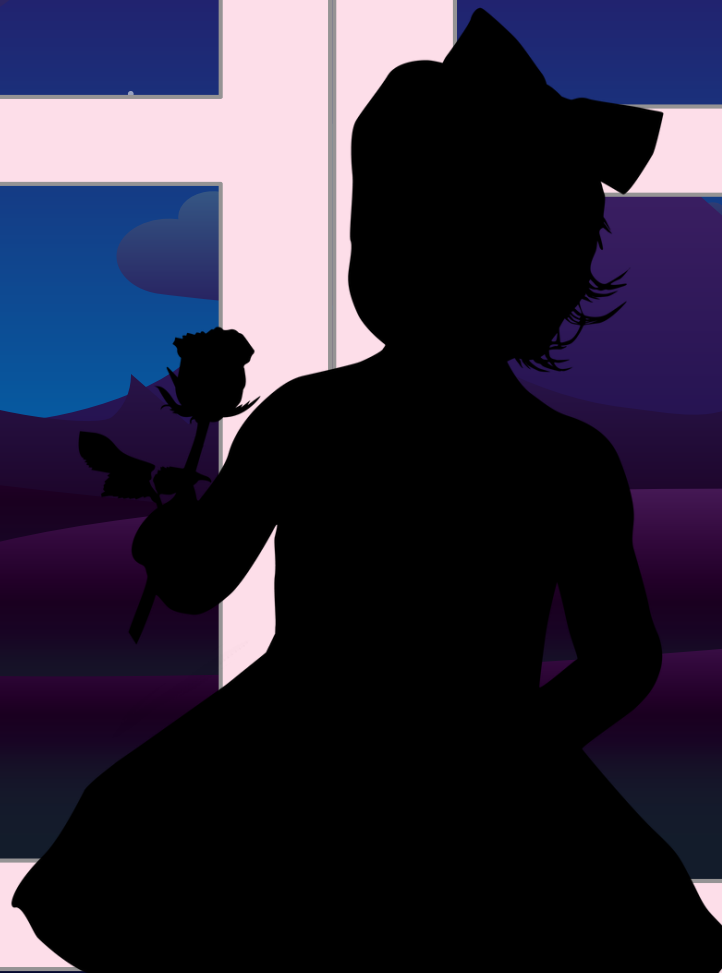
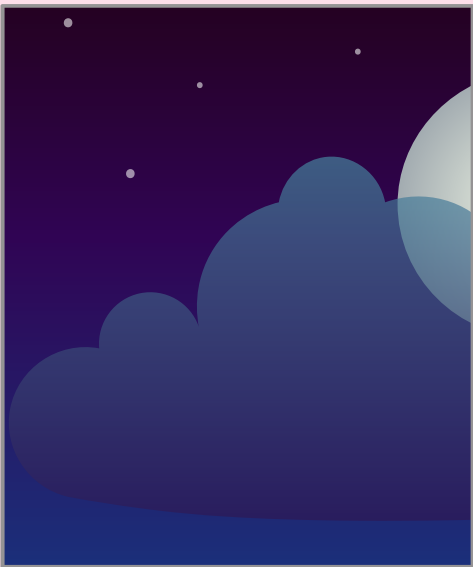


Luna's Lost Star

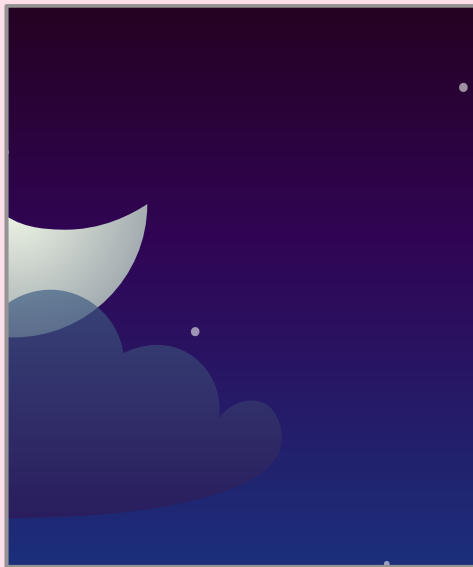
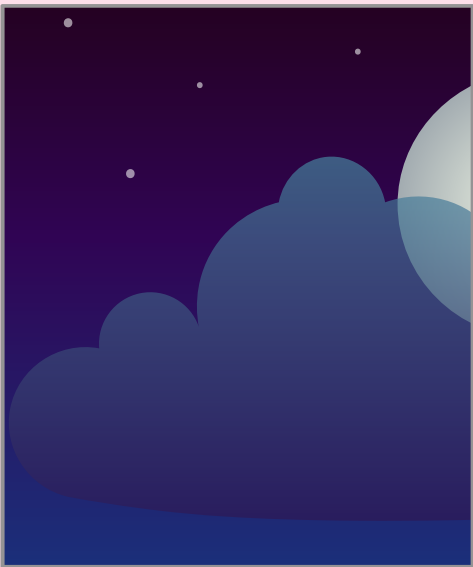
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Once upon a time, in a quiet village,

twinkled back into the sky.*



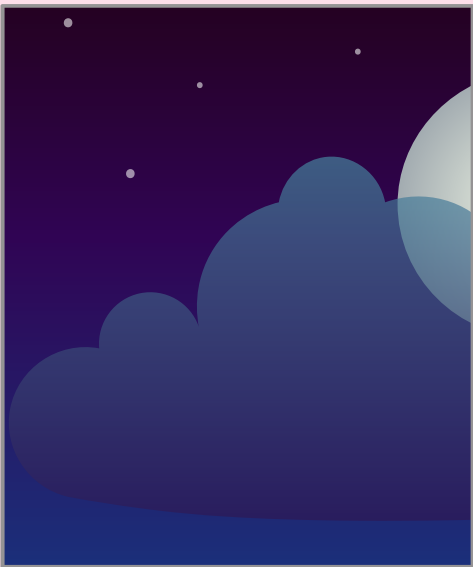
*“Thank you, Luna!” said Spark.
