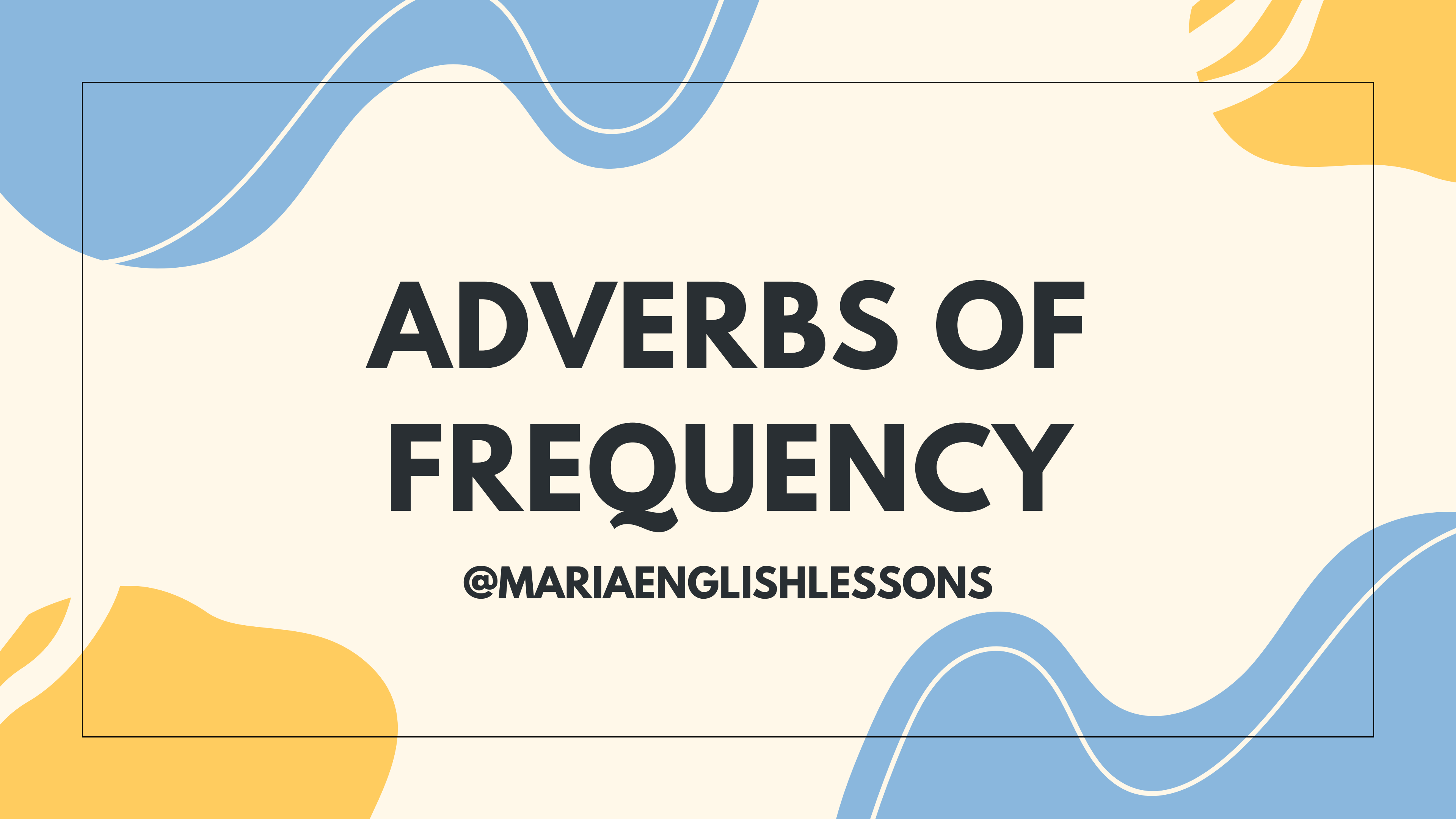

INTRODUCTION

- Welcome to our presentation on "Adverbs of Frequency."
- Definition: Adverbs of frequency provide information about how often an action happens.



Types of Adverbs of Frequency

- Always (Siempre) (100%)
- Usually (Generalmente) (80-99%)
- Often (A menudo) (60-79%)
- Sometimes (A veces) (40-59%)
- Rarely (Raramente) (20-39%)
- Seldom (Raramente) (20-39%) - menos común que "rarely"
- Hardly ever (Casi nunca) (0-19%)
- Never (Nunca) (0%)





Placement of Adverbs of Frequency

- Adverbs of frequency are commonly placed before the main verb in a sentence.
- Examples:
 - She always eats breakfast.
 - He rarely watches TV.
- They can also be placed at the beginning or end of a sentence for emphasis.
- Example: Often, I go for a walk in the evening.

COMMON MISTAKES

- Avoid placing adverbs of frequency between the verb and the object.
- Incorrect: She eats always chocolate.
- Correct: She always eats chocolate.



Frequency Adverbs in Questions

- Adverbs of frequency are often used in questions to ask how often something happens.
- Example: How often do you visit your grandparents?
- The adverb is placed before the main verb in questions.





Frequency Adverbs with Other Time Expressions

- Adverbs of frequency can be combined with other time expressions.
- Examples:
 - I usually go to the gym in the morning.
 - They always travel during the summer.

FREQUENCY ADVERBS IN NEGATIVE SENTENCES

- When used in negative sentences, adverbs of frequency are placed before the auxiliary verb.
- Example: She doesn't always finish her homework on time.





Importance in Communication

- Helps in understanding routines, habits, and regular activities in conversations.
