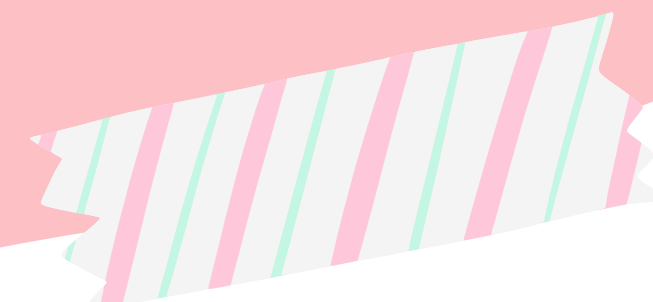
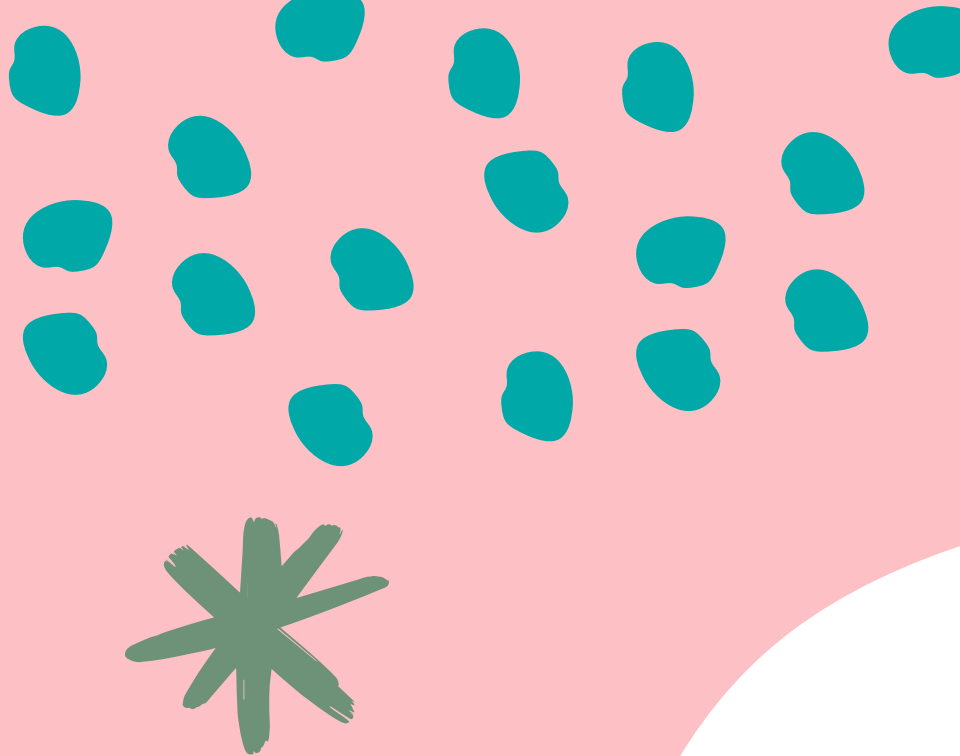


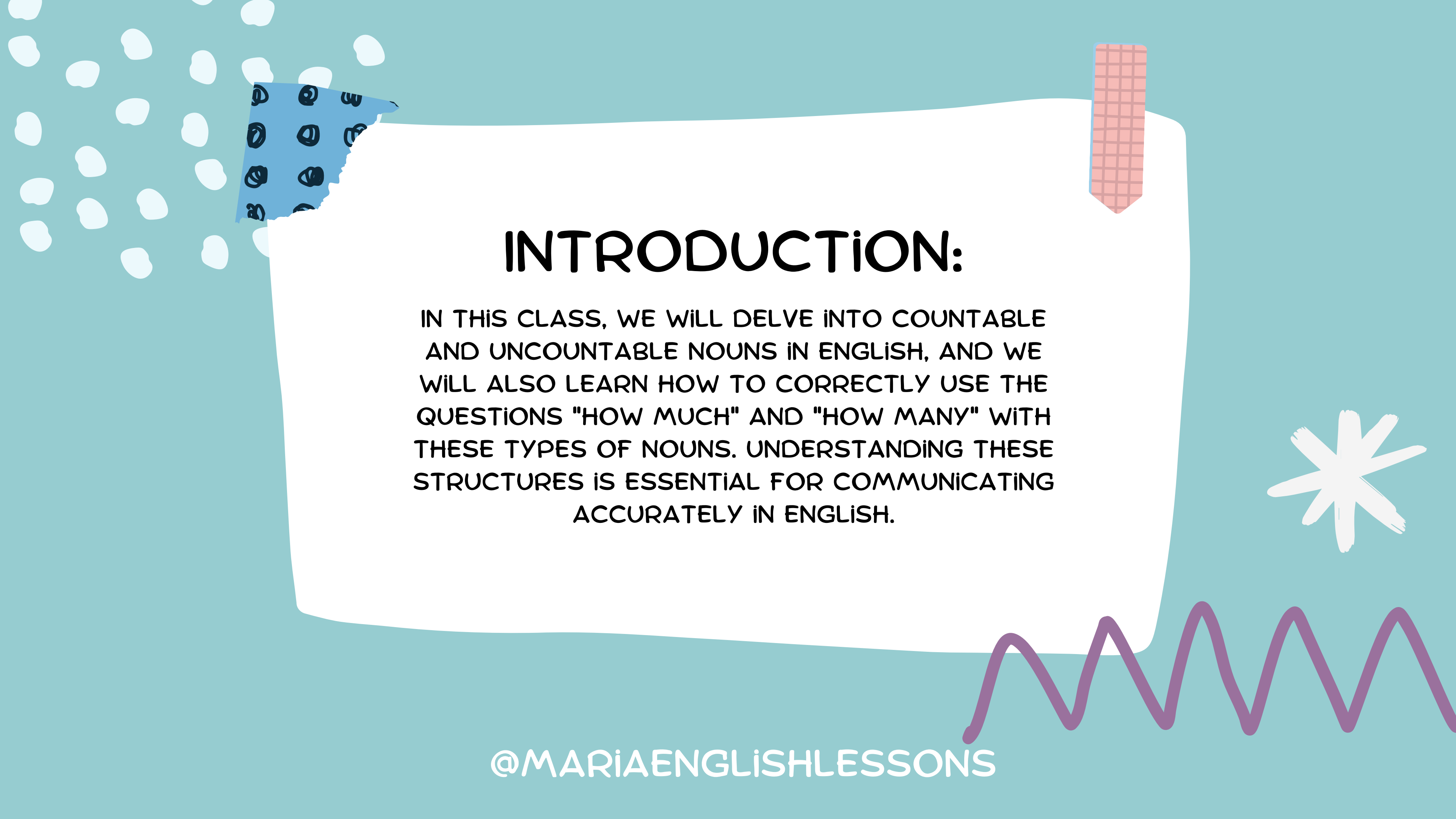

INTRODUCTION:

IN THIS CLASS, WE WILL DELVE INTO COUNTABLE AND UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS IN ENGLISH, AND WE WILL ALSO LEARN HOW TO CORRECTLY USE THE QUESTIONS "HOW MUCH" AND "HOW MANY" WITH THESE TYPES OF NOUNS. UNDERSTANDING THESE STRUCTURES IS ESSENTIAL FOR COMMUNICATING ACCURATELY IN ENGLISH.

I. COUNTABLE NOUNS:

DEFINITION: COUNTABLE NOUNS ARE OBJECTS, PEOPLE, OR PLACES THAT CAN BE COUNTED INDIVIDUALLY.

EXAMPLES:

SINGULAR: CAR, BOOK, DOG
PLURAL: CARS, BOOKS, DOGS

ARTICLE USAGE: COUNTABLE NOUNS ARE USUALLY ACCOMPANIED BY DEFINITE ARTICLES (THE) OR INDEFINITE ARTICLES (A/AN) IN THE SINGULAR FORM AND CAN BE EASILY COUNTED.

USING "HOW MANY" WITH COUNTABLE NOUNS:

"HOW MANY" IS USED WITH COUNTABLE NOUNS TO INQUIRE ABOUT THE NUMBER OF ITEMS.

EXAMPLE: HOW MANY BOOKS ARE ON THE SHELF?

II. UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS:

DEFINITION: UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS ARE THINGS THAT CANNOT BE COUNTED INDIVIDUALLY, SUCH AS SUBSTANCES, CONCEPTS, OR QUALITIES.

EXAMPLES:
WATER, KNOWLEDGE, HAPPINESS

ARTICLE USAGE:
UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS ARE USED WITH DEFINITE ARTICLES (THE) OR NO ARTICLE AT ALL. THEY DO NOT HAVE A PLURAL FORM.

USING "HOW MUCH" WITH UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS:
"HOW MUCH" IS USED WITH UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS TO INQUIRE ABOUT THE QUANTITY OR AMOUNT.
EXAMPLE: HOW MUCH WATER IS IN THE GLASS?



III. KEY DIFFERENCES:

COUNTABLE VS. UNCOUNTABLE:

COUNTABLE NOUNS CAN BE COUNTED INDIVIDUALLY.

UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS CANNOT BE COUNTED INDIVIDUALLY.

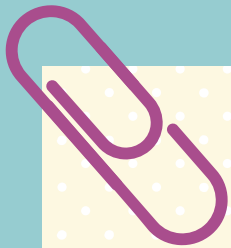
QUESTIONS WITH "HOW MANY" AND "HOW MUCH":

USE "HOW MUCH" WITH UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS TO ASK ABOUT THE QUANTITY OR AMOUNT.



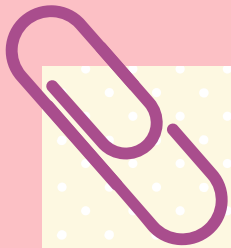

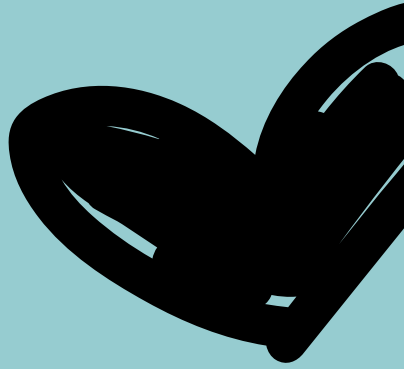
