REWRITE SENTENCES

Tenses

1. I didn't realise he was standing behind me. (Rewrite in the present perfect.)

2. She was reading when the phone rang. (Rewrite using the past perfect.)

3. They are building a new sports centre in town. (Rewrite in the present perfect passive.)

4. I haven't seen him for two months. (Rewrite using "since".)

5. By the time we arrived, the movie had already started. (Rewrite using the past perfect continuous.)

Conditionals

1. I don't have enough money, so I can't buy a new laptop. (Rewrite as a second conditional.)

2. She didn't study, so she failed the exam. (Rewrite as a third conditional.)

3. If you heat ice, it melts. (Rewrite as a first conditional.)

4. I'll go for a walk if it stops raining. (Rewrite with "unless".)

5. He might get lost because he doesn't have a map. (Rewrite as a mixed conditional.)

Modals

I'm sure he isn't telling the truth.(Rewrite using a modal of deduction.)

It's necessary for you to wear a helmet.(Rewrite using "must".)

It was a good idea for you to call her.(Rewrite using "should have".)

I advise you to talk to your manager.(Rewrite using "ought to".)

Passive / Reported speech

1.People believe that the company will announce new products soon.(Rewrite in the passive.)

2.They have cancelled the flight due to the storm.(Rewrite in the passive form.)

3."I can't come because I'm working," she said.(Rewrite in reported speech.)

4.They are repairing my car right now.(Rewrite in the passive.)

5."Do you need any help?" he asked me.(Rewrite in reported speech.)

Relative Clauses / Comparisons / Other Grammar

The book is very interesting. I bought it yesterday.(Rewrite using a relative clause.)

This hotel isn't as expensive as the one we stayed in last year.(Rewrite using a comparative.)

She started learning French two years ago and still studies it.(Rewrite using the present perfect continuous.)

I regret telling him the truth.(Rewrite using "wish".)

He's too young to drive a car.(Rewrite using "not ... enough".)

The teacher said to us, "Finish the exercise now." (Rewrite using reported speech.)

The man is talking to Sarah. He used to be her neighbour.(Rewrite using a defining relative clause.)

It wasn't necessary for you to bring your laptop, but you did.(Rewrite using "needn't have".)

The last time I went to the gym was in April.(Rewrite using "haven't" in present perfect.)

I didn't expect the test to be so difficult.(Rewrite using a comparative.)
