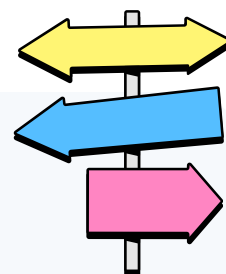

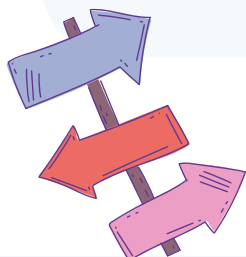

A Walk Around My Town

My town is small but very nice. There are many streets, shops, and places to visit. In the centre of the town there is a big square called Central Square. Many people meet there. There is a café, a restaurant, and a bookshop in the square. The bookshop is next to the café.

From the square, you can go straight along Main Street. On the left there is a bank and a pharmacy. On the right there is a supermarket and a clothes shop. If you turn right at the traffic lights, you enter Park Avenue. On this avenue there is a large park where families walk and children play. Next to the park there is a library.

If you go straight and then turn left, you arrive at Green Street. The hospital is on this street, opposite the police station.

The school is near the bus station. If you walk past the school and cross the street, you can see the cinema and a small bakery.

My favourite place is the park because it is quiet and beautiful.
