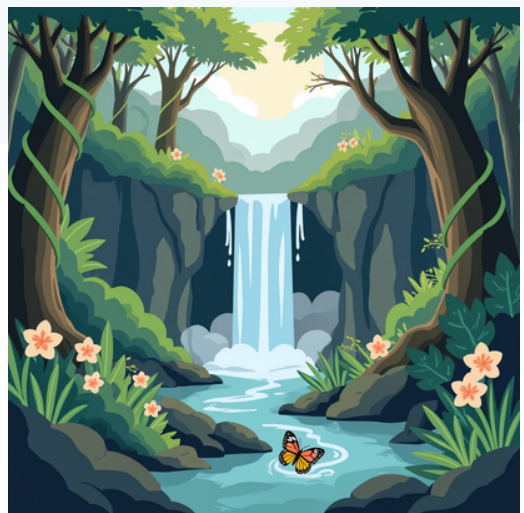
Reading
